Hello Teachers,

If you have elected to eat lunch at Ijams Nature Center before or after your **Science Discovery Program**, here are some things to remember:

- ✓ Please remember to bring trash bags to take your garbage back to your school. **All groups are required to dispose of their trash off-site.**
- ✓ Please remind bus drivers that idling is prohibited in Ijams Nature Center parking lots.
- ✓ Indoor alternatives are available during inclement weather conditions. In the event of rain, we can offer indoor space for lunch.
- ✓ Recycling facilities for plastic, aluminum, and paper are available for use. Please supervise recycling efforts to ensure minimum contamination of recycling bins with improperly sorted recyclables. Bins containing a large amount of contamination cannot be recycled.
- ✓ If your group chooses to take advantage of our gift shop, please be sure that students enter the gift shop in groups of 5-8 students. Each group must be supervised by an adult. **Science Discovery Program** itineraries do not include time for shopping, so please restrict purchases to before and/or after your scheduled field trip time.
