Grade K

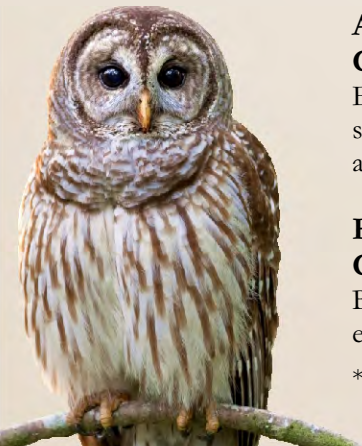
