## Poetry & Art Contest eligibility

Theme:

*Puddles to Ponds*

*Open to students in grades K-12*

### Poster entries:

- ❖ must be submitted on white, 11"X17" paper.
- ❖ must be in color and completed
- ❖ crayons, colored pencils, water colors, or markers may be used.
- ❖ paints such as oils, pastels or latex are not to be used.
- ❖ glitter is not to be used.

### Poetry entries:

- ❖ all poetry forms are accepted.
- ❖ must not exceed 20 lines or 100 words.

### All entries:

- ❖ need to be submitted no later than **Friday, March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2012** with a completed entry form.
- ❖ will be judged in the following groups: K&1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>&3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>&5<sup>th</sup>, middle school, and high school; prizes will be awarded in each group.
- ❖ become the property of WaterFest & may be used by WaterFest and the Water Quality Forum in displays and publications.
- ❖ will be exhibited at Ijams until the end of May. After that time, any students that wish may come get their entries.

**There will be a grand prize winner in the Poster Contest and the Poetry Contest.** These winners may be from any grade. The grand prize entries will be reprinted on a shirt that will be given to each WaterFest participant at this year's WaterFest celebration on May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2012.
