

Trail Map

Riverside Trails

● Easy ■ Moderate ◆ Difficult

Whether you're visiting the trails around the original Jans Homestead or walking the famous River Boardwalk, the riverside trails hold Jans history in every step.

- **River Landing Rd 0.2 mi**
This flat gravel drive leads to limited parking for paddlers and a public access dock on the Tennessee River.
- **Serenity 0.3 mi**
An easy paved loop winding around the old Jans Homestead gardens and pocket meadows.
- **Tower 0.3 mi**
This trail connects the Visitor Center to River Landing and features one of the highest art points at Jans.
- **Secret Pond 0.1 mi**
A short walk to a historic home site.
- **Will Shelton Greenway 3.5 mi at Jans, 3.8 total**
This 3.8-mile paved greenway with great views connects Jans to Island Home Park and Forks of the River Wildlife Management Area, has quite a few hills, and parallels the Tennessee River.
- **Universal 0.2 mi**
A short, paved loop that winds through forests and meadows.
- ◆ **North Cove 0.2 mi**
A trail descending the cliffs through a beautiful example of cove hardwood forest behind the Visitor Center.
- **Amelia 0.1 mi**
A short trail connecting the main Overflow lot across from the Visitor Center to the Jans Quarries through a grove of rhododendron, hawthorn, and devil's walking stick.
- **Discovery 0.6 mi**
These trails ramble through a historic woodland rock garden and lead to quiet river overlooks and the Lotus Pond.
- ◆ **River 0.5 mi**
A lovely walk that includes the historic Jans River Boardwalk and spectacular views of the Tennessee River.
- **Toll Creek 0.1 mi**
A short trail featuring a quiet creek and small boardwalk in bottomland's hardwood forest.

Quarryside Trails

● Easy ■ Moderate ◆ Difficult

From wondrous quarry rock formations being reclaimed by nature to old-growth forests and ephemeral wetlands that pop up during specific times of the year, the quarryside trails are great for hikers and mountain bikers alike.

- **Burnett Ridge 1.5 mi**
This twisting trail features views from above the Jans Ore and rambles through former quarry operations.
- **Hayworth Hollow 0.1 mi**
A hidden treasure where temperatures drop while traveling along the quarry gorge to a stunning view of sheer rock walls.
- **Pink Marble 0.3 mi**
A rambling, easy trail to the Primal Playground and beautiful lake overlooks.
- **Nature Playscapes 0.4 mi**
This gentle trail takes children to adventure play "rooms" in the Jans Nature Playscape at Grayson Subaru Preserve, and includes access to plots dedicated to citizen science.
- **Flow 1.0 mi**
A fun trail full of splash turns and forest views.
- ◆ **Turnbuckle 1.1 mi**
A trail full of twists and turns, rock outcroppings, and bridges.
- **Imagry 1.1 mi**
The backbones of the Jans Quarries trail system, Imagry is a wide connector to many trails.
- **Hickory 0.7 mi**
This trail ascends through old upland hardwood forests and seasonal, ephemeral wetlands.
- **Gravel Road 0.2 mi**
This short, easy trail is a quick connector to Hickory, Flow, and Turnbuckle.
- **Rose Marble 1.2 mi**
This winding trail along limestone walls echoes back to its industrial past.
- ◆ **Tharp Trace 1.0 mi**
This challenging trail, which leads to the highest point at Jans, passes by the Historic Strata Cemetery and features amazing views of the landscape, including the distant Mt. LeConte.
- ◆ **Rock Bridge 0.1 mi**
This man-made bridge takes you over The Keyhole and provides great views of "God's Chain".
